

Chichester will be hosting a **Charity Café Bridge** Event on 22nd May 2019. Café Bridge has become a popular and fun way of raising money for charity and with the abundance of cafés in Chichester it seems a good opportunity to stage an event to raise money for St Wilfrid's Hospice. This is a relaxed duplicate bridge event, where the focus is as much on the social aspect as on the bridge. The event is advertised on the Café Bridge Website brianbridge.net/café, as we have secured the services of London based Café Bridge expert Victor Lesk to run the day for us.

How does the Chichester Café Bridge Work?

All players meet at the Assembly Rooms in Chichester between 10.00 and 10.45 am where they will be given instructions and a map of venues. They then make their way to the first venue on their list and play 5 hands of bridge. On completion of the hands, players proceed to the next venue and play again, proceeding in this way until all 25 boards have been played.

Lunch is provided in the venue where the participants are playing the second round.

Refreshments can be purchased throughout the day at any of the venues.

All further details can be found on the attached poster, together with the names of the cafés involved. All profits will go to St Wilfrid's, as will the proceeds of the raffle.
